As of April,7 we have been doing a small group study called Patterns of Evidence: The Red Sea Crossing by Timothy Mahoney.

<u>Description:</u> "Patterns of Evidence: The Red Sea Miracle" continues to raise big questions about biblical miracles. This series is by Patterns of Evidence's award-winning filmmaker, Timothy Mahoney. How could thousands of feet of water be parted at the Red Sea? Or was the sea merely parted by the act of wind in nature, through a shallow Egyptian lake? Mahoney investigates these locations to see if any have a pattern of evidence matching the Bible. People of faith will be inspired and skeptics will have much to think about as Mahoney reveals two decades of documentary research including if divers found the remains of Pharaoh's army on the seafloor. This cinematic journey leads him to inquire... "Do miracles still happen today?"

Dive Deeper into this riveting evidence for a deep sea crossing and its impact on our faith. This small group study includes thought-provoking questions that will help you explore key scenes from the film and why it matters today.
